Abu Dhabi. Opening of the world's largest indoor park. 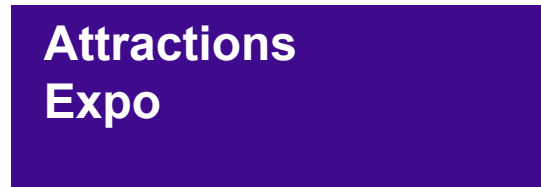
Spinning Coaster for Bobbejaanland 2011
